

## 11<sup>th</sup> Stable Isotope Network Austria (SINA) Meeting

4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER,  
University of Vienna

The 11<sup>th</sup> Austrian Stable Isotope User Group Meeting is jointly organized by the Department of Chemical Ecology and Ecosystem Research (Faculty of Life Sciences) and the Department of Geodynamics and Sedimentology (Faculty of Earth Sciences, Geography and Astronomy), both University of Vienna.

Stable isotope analyses provide exciting new approaches in a variety of current research topics ranging from Earth and Biological to Forensic and Medical Sciences. This meeting aims to bring together researchers and students in an informal workshop-like atmosphere to improve communication and interaction within and across disciplines and institutions. The meeting will include invited and contributed talks, as well as poster presentations.

### Date and Venue

The meeting will take place on 4 November 2011, 14-18 hrs, and 5 November, 9-16 hrs. The conference will be held at Lecture Hall 2, Geocenter, UZA 2, Althanstraße 14, 1090 Vienna.

### Scientific program

The meeting will consist of three blocks of oral sessions, covering *Earth Sciences*, *Biological Sciences* and *Miscellaneous & Emerging Techniques*. Keynote lectures will be given by Bruno Benner (MPI Marine Microbiology, Bremen; Title: Sulfate oxygen isotopes to trace marine dissimilatory sulphate reduction) and Nick Brüggemann (FZ Jülich, Title: Application of isotope-specific infrared laser spectroscopy in ecosystem research). The conference program will be announced in the final circular shortly after closing of the registration.

### Abstract submission

Regular oral presentation will be 20-minute talks (including 5 min discussion). Posters are welcome and each poster will be presented by a 3 min "speed" presentation in front of the poster. Abstracts of all presentations (oral and posters) should be sent by e-mail as attachment (word format) to: [checo@univie.ac.at](mailto:checo@univie.ac.at) and should include title, authors, affiliation and abstract (maximum 350 words). It is possible to include small illustrations. Abstracts will be provided by the organizers as download on this website and in print form at the meeting.
